How to Register for Classes

- Return a completed Course Request to your academic advisor on or before the course deadline date.
- A Course Request may be downloaded at <http://academics.biola.edu/bold/currentstudents/electives/> or is available from your Education Center.
- If we receive the Course Request, along with the tuition down payment and any outstanding balance from a previous Bible or G.E. class by 5:00 p.m. on or before the published deadline, a place in the class will be held for you based on availability. Some classes have a limited seating capacity and may fill early.
- If you submit a Course Request and/or pay the down payment in the two weeks after the registration deadline, you will be assessed a \$120 late registration fee. One week before the class begins, Course Requests will no longer be accepted.
- If you send in a Course Request and later decide not to take the course, contact your academic advisor. See the Student Handbook for details on drops and refunds. Contact Financial Aid regarding the possible impact on your financial aid package.

Textbooks and Coursepacks

- You can expect to receive a cover letter by e-mail detailing your class information and materials 2-3 weeks prior to the start of the class, provided that you registered by the deadline. A PDF document(s) will be attached to your e-mail.
- If you do not receive this e-mail, or if you registered late, it is your responsibility to contact the Education Center where the class is located to obtain the course information.
- Textbooks and coursepacks may be purchased from the Biola Bookstore at www.biolabookstore.com one month prior to the start date of a course. Allow at least one week for delivery of your materials. Most courses have reading and/or written assignments due at the first class session. Please plan your purchases accordingly.
