



ENRICHMENT STUDENT APPLICATION BOLD PROGRAM

Enrichment Student Status is for those individuals who do not wish to pursue the BOLD program and do not desire to take BOLD Bible classes for credit. Enrichment students are exempt from assignments, reading of texts, and recorded attendance. Enrichment classes may only be taken at Extension Sites, other than La Mirada. Note that classes taken through enrichment can never be converted into university credit, nor can the same class be repeated at a later time for credit.

APPLICATION PROCESS

- ___ Complete the Enrichment Application & Testimony
- ___ Pastoral Reference must be completed and submitted directly to BOLD, unless the applicant has been enrolled in one of Biola University’s programs within the last two years
- ___ Submit a \$39 per unit course fee
- ___ Typed, one-page statement indicating your reason for pursuing Enrichment Student Status
- ___ Read through Biola University’s Doctrinal Statement

I understand and agree that, in registering for a BOLD class on an enrichment basis, class space is available only when registered BOLD students have not filled all seats. If BOLD students should register after this application has been received, the BOLD student will have precedence over enrichment students. Enrichment students, however, will be allowed into the class on a first-come, first-served basis.
