Church Matching Scholarship Guidelines

Additional Application Required

- Students who are U.S. citizens or permanent residents must file a 2011-2012 FAFSA by the scholarship deadline.
- ELSP students and international students who hold an F-1 visa do not need to file a FAFSA.

Scholarship Terms

- The Church Matching Scholarship is based on need as determined by federal methodology. The scholarship will be coordinated with other need based financial aid.
- The deadline for students enrolled in the fall semester and/or the full academic year is October 3, 2011. The deadline for students enrolled in the spring semester is March 1, 2012.
- Students cannot receive the Church Matching Scholarship in the spring semester if they attended during the fall semester, even if they did not receive the Church Matching Scholarship in fall.
- Undergraduate students may receive a match for up to \$1,000; graduate and teaching credential students may receive a match for up to \$500.
- The Church Matching Scholarship is institutional aid which can only be applied towards on-campus tuition, room and board.
- Extensions or exceptions will not be granted.
- Funds are awarded in the order that applications are received, as long as funds are available.

Student Eligibility

- The student must be enrolled full time for the full match. If the student is not enrolled full time, the match will be prorated. To be eligible for a partial scholarship, undergraduate students must be enrolled in at least 6 units; graduate and teaching credential students must be enrolled in at least 5 units.
- Graduate students working on a dissertation can be considered full time with only 3 units.
- Eligibility for the Church Matching Scholarship will be determined after the student's financial aid file has been completed and reviewed.

Church Donation Eligibility

- The church may not submit funds from wages, internships or gifts from individuals to a specific student for the Church Matching Scholarship.
- Only one church check per year will be matched. Subsequent checks will be applied to the student's account without a match.
- For the purposes of this scholarship, a "church" is understood as a congregation holding weekly services/meetings. Donations from other non-profit organizations will not be matched.
- The church will be notified if a student is ineligible for the match, and will have the option to rescind their donation.
- International students must hold an F-1 visa in order to be eligible. International students holding other visas are not eligible.

Program Eligibility

- Doctor of Ministry students are ineligible for the Church Matching Scholarship.
- Students in special programs are not eligible for this scholarship, including but not limited to BOLD, MOL, MA Apologetics, and Chang Mai, etc.
- ELSP students are eligible for one Church Matching Scholarship during their first two semesters of enrollment. No matches will be awarded subsequent to that time.
